Firefighters are then expected to take additional courses and weekly drills to maintain their skills. In addition, GFD members who become NYS certified EMTs (Emergency Medical Technician) take a 100+ hour course, spanning four months of classes - all as volunteers!


The GFD is the most active volunteer fire agency in Saratoga County! Here are the calls to date (since January up to September) for each sister fire company of the GFD:

Lake Desolation Residents Continue to Make Improvements

The residents of the Happy Hill area of Lake Desolation have been busy making improvements to better the Fire District's ability to respond to their houses in the event of an emergency. At a recent meeting an association was formed to continue improving the condition of the roads and to improve the house numbering system. Company #3 Assistant Chief Jay Ellsworth and Commissioner Brian Bishop attended the last meeting and were very pleased with the turnout of 30 - 40 concerned residents and the excellent progress being made. Both look forward to continuing working with the residents to improve the district's ability to respond in an emergency.

GFD 2009 Budget

The GFD Board of Fire Commissioners is proud to announce a proposed 2009 overall budget increase of 3%. LOSAP investment growth was larger than anticipated and enrollment in the program was lower than projected. This created a surplus of monies which was used to cover other large increases in operating expenses, which minimized the overall budget increase to only 3%.

A public informational meeting will be held Tuesday October 21st at 7 pm at the Greenfield Center firehouse.

Middle Grove Emergency Generator Installed

The GFD completed the installation of an emergency generator at the Middle Grove firehouse in July. This generator will power the entire facility in the event of a power outage. Part of this generator was paid for from a generous grant from the Office of Senator Hugh Farley. The GFD is currently researching the feasibility of installing a generator at the Porter Corners firehouse this year rather than next year.
